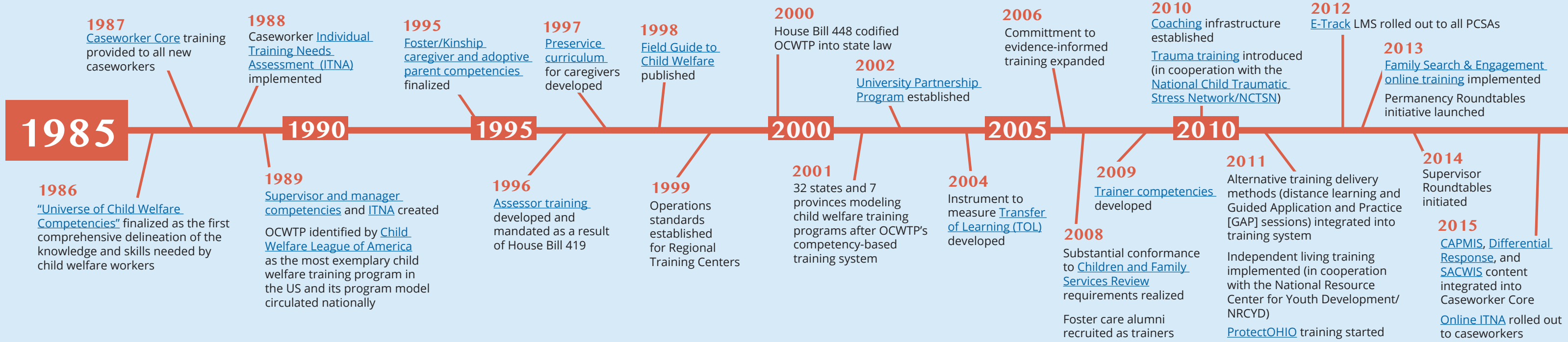


A Pioneering Impact on the Field of Child Welfare Training and Development



In 2016 the [National Staff Development and Training Association \(NSDTA\)](#) selected [OCWTP](#) as recipient of the [President's Award for Pioneering Impact on the Field of Human Service Training and Development](#). This special award was created to recognize the OCWTP's contributions to the field as a national leader in child welfare training for over 30 years.

The NSDTA recognized OCWTP for being the first systemic, competency-based approach to child welfare training in the United States. OCWTP is a public/private partnership-between the [Ohio Department of Job and Family Services \(ODJFS\)](#), the [Public Children Services Association of Ohio \(PCSAO\)](#), eight [Regional Training Centers \(RTCs\)](#), and the OCWTP's state training coordinator, the [Institute for Human Services \(IHS\)](#). This partnership and its state/county/local management structure were unique in 1985, and remain an exemplary model of effective collaboration.

More than tripled the number of CAPMIS courses completed across the state in 2015—thanks to the endorsement of agency directors and supervisors who took the training and recognized its value

Received the first [President's Award for Pioneering Impact on the Field of Human Service Training and Development](#) from the [National Staff Development and Training Association \(NSDTA\)](#)

Rolled out a streamlined online [Individual Training Needs Assessment \(ITNA\) tool for supervisors](#)—with a response rate of 96%

Increased the variety and frequency of our distance learnings—overcoming barriers of time and location to better meet our learners' needs

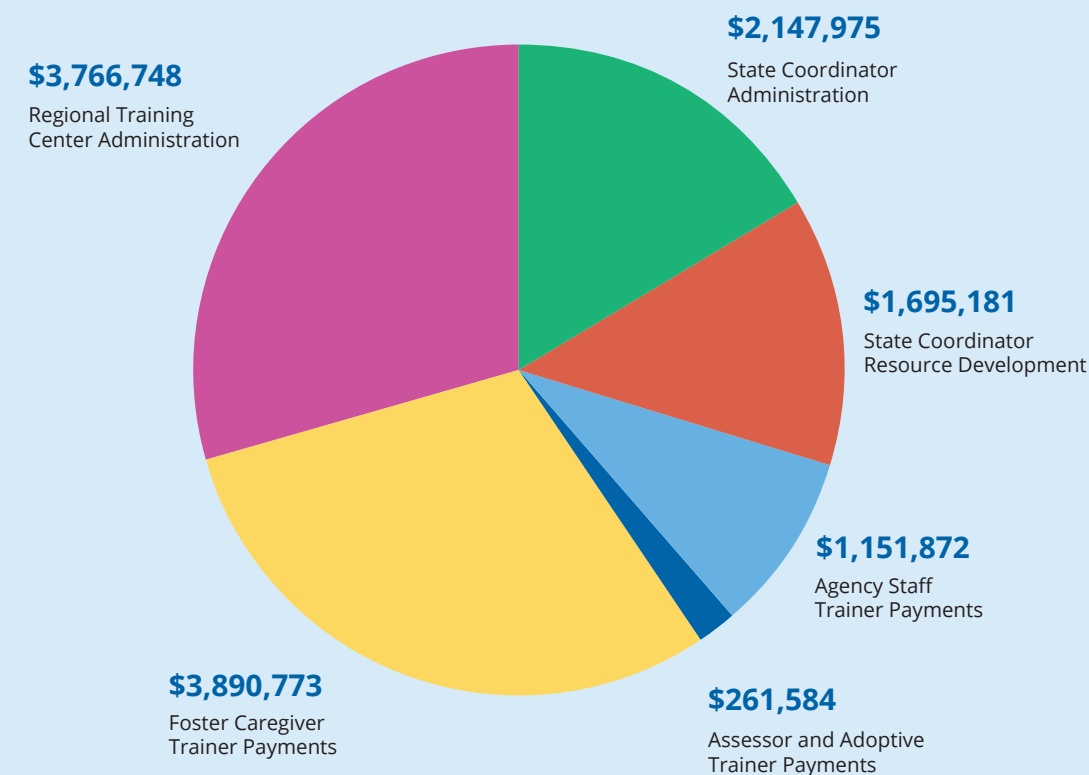

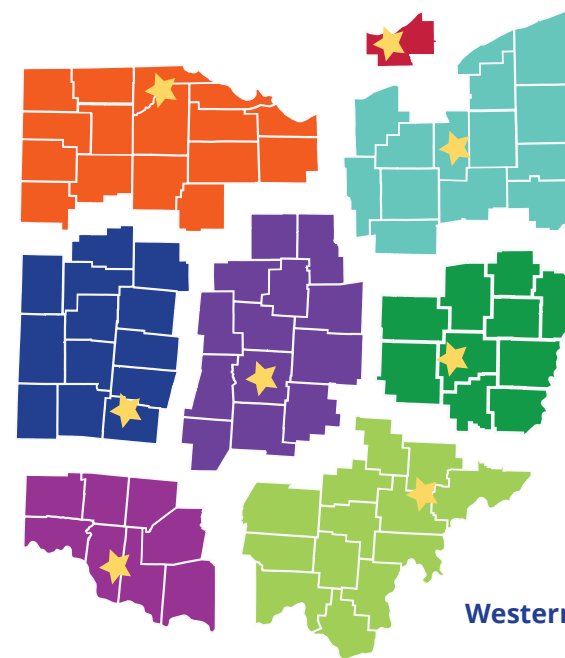

The OCWTP divides Ohio into eight [Regional Training Centers \(RTCs\)](#), each of which is responsible for budgeting, scheduling, registration, and administration of child welfare related training within its region.

Each RTC collaborates with its constituent agencies to identify training needs, implement training, promote Transfer of Learning, and address other training-related issues.

* *Mixed* refers to trainings designed for a mix of both staff and caregivers.
