



What Caregivers Need to Know About Human Trafficking

...an online course for foster caregivers in Ohio

An estimated 1,110 children are currently trafficked for sex in Ohio.

This online course was developed to provide Ohio caregivers with essential information about human trafficking. The course is divided into three parts and takes about one hour to complete. Participants will learn:

- The definition of sex and labor trafficking
- A description of the scope and prevalence of the problem
- How to recognize if children have been trafficked
- Issues unique to Ohio and to youth in care that could increase their vulnerability to trafficking
- Prevention strategies for children and youth placed in foster care
- Strategies for organizing the home and establishing family relationships to reduce vulnerabilities
- Prevention strategies for the community
