CAPMIS Safety Planning

This standardized *CAPMIS Safety Planning* workshop for caseworkers and supervisors is a three-hour session. It provides a detailed explanation of how safety plans are intended to keep children safe and reviews the components of an effective safety plan.

The workshop covers:

- The connection between safety assessment and safety planning
- Different types of safety plans and how to determine an effective safety response
- How to assess responsible persons included in safety planning
- Common errors in safety planning
- Safety plan monitoring requirements

Participants will reflect on their own cases, provide examples from their work experience, and identify how to improve a real life safety plan. The workshop is CSWMFT Board-approved for social work and counselor CEUs.
